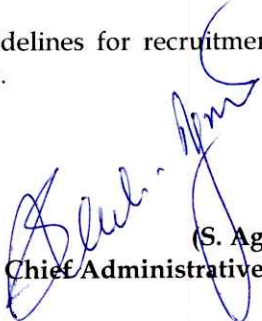

OFFICE ORDER

The Director, ICAR Research Complex for NEH Region, Umiam has approved the following guidelines and scorecard for the recruitment of various contractual positions of RA/SRF/JRF/YP, etc. under different projects & schemes:

1. The PI/In-charges/Nodal Officers of the respective Project/Schemes shall send the self-contained proposals for obtaining approval of the Competent Authority mentioning all the relevant details and also proposing the Selection Committee for the contractual positions & tentative date of interview, etc. through their respective Heads of Division/Regional Centre strictly via e-office only to the Recruitment Cell for further processing.
2. Upon obtaining the approval of the Competent Authority, the contractual vacant positions shall be notified/advertised by the PI/In-charges/Nodal Officers in the Institute Website/Local Newspapers and they shall conduct the selection process on the approved dates. If the number of candidates are high a written test may be conducted to shortlist candidates for interview at the discretion of PI/In-charges/Nodal Officers. This condition should invariably be mentioned in the advertisement of the contractual positions.
3. The proceedings & scorecards of the selection process shall also have to be sent via e-office in the respective files to the Recruitment Cell for further processing and obtaining approval of the Competent Authority. Not more than 2 (two) candidates should be kept in waiting list for a post. The waiting list for a particular post shall become invalid once a candidate joins the post and for future vacancies in the same post fresh recruitment process has to be carried out. The model scorecards for different posts are enclosed herewith and PI/In-charges/Nodal Officers should strictly adhere to the same.
4. Upon obtaining the approval from Competent Authority the PI/In-charges/Nodal Officers shall issue offer of appointment to the selected candidates from their end. Once a candidate joins the particular position a copy of the joining report & offer of appointment shall be endorsed to the Accounts Section & respective DDO. Further the PI/In-charges shall be responsible for seeking timely extension regarding the contractual service period of YPs, etc.
5. Proposals for sanction of fresh posts of YP, etc. under Institute Budget, enhancement of salary, extension of tenure, etc. should be sent with a self-contained note via the e-office only.
6. Processing of vacancies for YPs, etc. in the Administration, Finance & Accounts, Legal, Estate & Health Centre shall be done by the Recruitment Cell upon receiving vacancy requisition from the respective In-charges.

All the PI/In-charges/Nodal Officers shall strictly follow the above guidelines for recruitment of all contractual positions like RA/SRF/JRF/YP, etc. under different projects & schemes.
